# How to use the electric range

## Controls



## Ignite/Extinguish



- 1. Press and hold [Power] for 2 seconds.
- 2. Press [Burner] to select the burner you want to use.
- 2. Set the heat level using [Heat control].
- 4. After cooking is complete, select the [burner] you want to turn off and slide the [heat control] all the way to the left. The heat will change to 0. You can also press 0 to turn off the heat.

### **Booster feature**

1. Turn on the power and select a [burner], then slide [heat control] all the way to the right or touch P.

### **Bridge feature**



- 1. Press and hold the buttons for the front and rear [burners] simultaneously with the power on.
  - To use, you need to put the right type of cookware on the burner.
- 2. Set the heat level using [Heat control].
- 3. The feature will turn off if the heat is set to 0.

### Keep warm



1. Turn on the power and press the button for the [burner] you want to use.



- 2. If you press [Keep Warm], the keep warm function is activated, and ( <u>u</u>. ) is displayed on the heat display.
- 3. With the warm feature on, press [Warm] once more to turn the feature off.

#### **Pause feature**



- 1. If you press [Pause] while the stove is on, ( / /) will be shown on the display and operation will pause.
- 2. Press [Pause] once more and press the [burner] button to restart operation.

#### **Setting a timer**

- **1. Press [burner] to select the burner you** want to use.
- 2. Press the [Timer Display]. ( D D ) will be shown.
- 3. Set the time using [+ or -]
- 4. When setup is complete, the LED for the burner with the timer set will be lit up on the burner display.
- 5. Select the burner with the timer set, then press [Timer Display] once the set time is shown and press [+ or -] to set to (  $\stackrel{+}{_{D}} \stackrel{+}{_{D}} \stackrel{+}{_{D}}$  ) to turn it off.

#### Heat-up feature



- **1.** Turn on the power and press the button for the [burner] you want to use.
- 2. Press and hold for 3 seconds the heat you want to automatically restore after heating for a set time at a maximum heat from 1-8.
- 3. ( $\ensuremath{\overline{R}}$  ) and the set heat blink, and the heat-up feature begins.
- 4. Press and hold the button for the [burner] for at least 3 seconds to turn the heat-up feature off.

### Alarm feature



### Safety lock



- 1. Turn on the power and press and hold [Lock/Unlock] for 2 seconds.
- 2. Press and hold [Lock/Unlock] once more for 2 seconds while the feature is on to turn it off.

#### **Recall feature**



- 1. If you turn the stove on within 5 seconds of turning it off, Pause will blink.
- 2. Press [Pause] to restart the stove at the heat that was set before it turned off.

If the top of the glass is hot, (H) is displayed as a warning.

### IH cookware(Front left, Rear left)

#### • Inattention protection

If foreign matter, etc. stays in contact with the controls for more than 10 seconds, an alarm will sound and the error code (-.) will be shown on the heat display.

#### Power cutoff

If you press [Power] but do not select a burner within 10 seconds, the power will automatically turn off.
